





A word from our GREENKEEPER...

JESSE VERSTER

Hi everyone. It looks like summer has arrived at last. We have started cutting the rough and fairways. The grass has been coming off more and more on our greens.

We have started verticutting greens last week, taking off thatch and old grass off the greens. That simply means that we rip the greens at minus 1 with a special machine to get the old grass off. We then put a bit of sand on to cover some bad spots that get ripped up more than other areas. We will be doing this on a regular basis slowly until we have all the thatch off.

This has to be done yearly to prevent diseases and to have more healthy greens at the end.

We will be aerating our greens again with solid tines, but just waiting for some rain.

We have been putting sand in more bunkers which will be an ongoing process.

We are not doing spring treatment this year because of the bridge closure. We don't want to chase people away as it takes time for the greens to recover. As soon as the bridge reopens we will decide, but it looks like we will be doing it at end of January.
